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Easy Step-by-Step Instructions

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STEP 1 – Remove any makeup from face and cleanse skin.



STEP 2 – Draw vein lines with



STEP 2 – Draw vein lines with Mehron's Green Pro-Pencil on neck, chest area and temples.





STEP 3 – Using Mehron's Tri-Color Palette, apply a thin, even coat of white on fae, lips, neck, chest and arms (if leaving exposed) lightly covering over the green veins.





STEP 6 - Complete the look with the included vampire teeth, and apply Temporary Black Hair Color also included in the kit.

STEP 4 – Using the Sponge Wedge and the black shade in the Tri-Color Palette, make defined "hollow" facial bones to accentuate cheeks, jaw and temples.

For female models: Create a smoky eye effect with Mehron's Tri-Color Palette black shade. Use your finger to smooth out black on corners of eyelids. Using the brush, eye-line the eye and define the eyebrows.

For male models: Use the same technique but create a lighter smoke on the eyelids with your fingertips.





STEP 5 - For female models: Using the brush, outline and color the lips with the Tri-Color Palette red shade. Using the brush, add Coagulated Blood on the corner of the lips and allow drips to fall creating blood drops.

For male models: Use only Coagulated Blood on the center of the top and bottom lips and allow drips to fall creating blood drops.

Enhance the look by creating fang marks by drawing two small dots with Coagulated Blood on neck.
